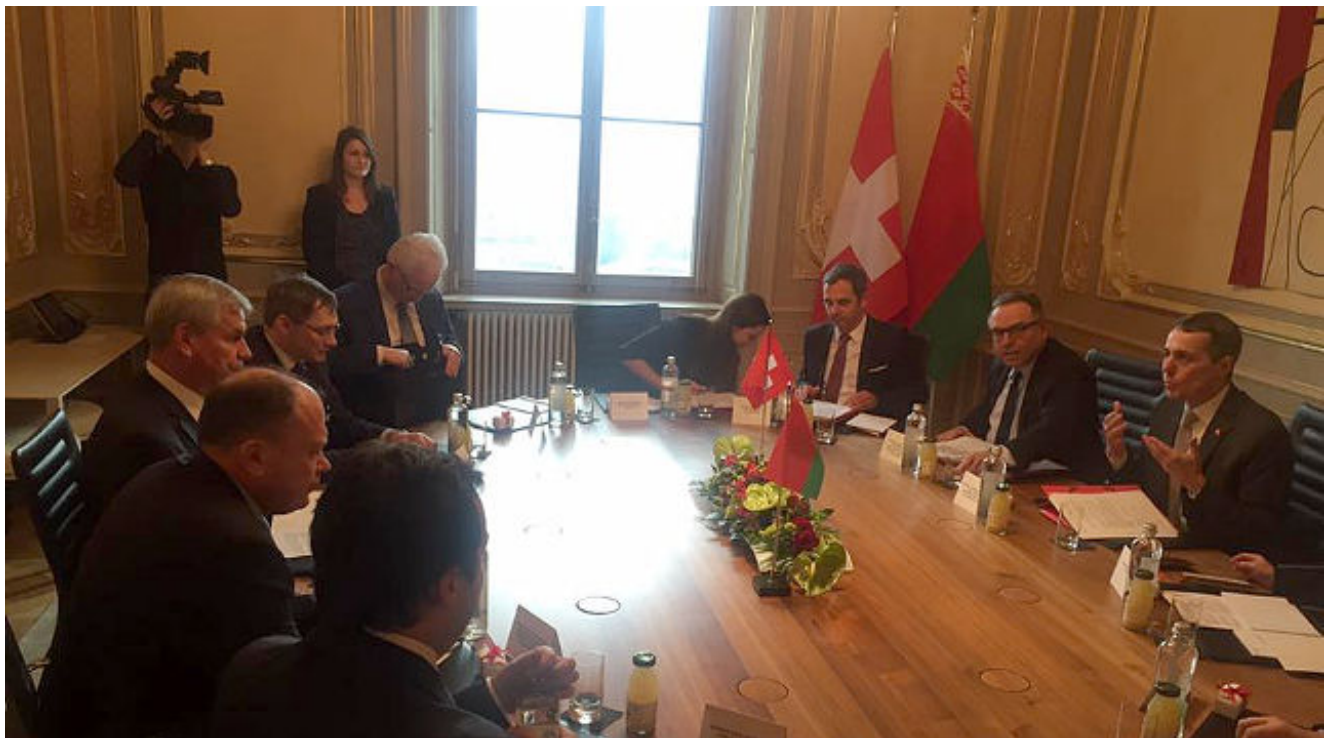

MINSK, 1 March (BelTA) – Regional security issues were discussed at a meeting of Chairman of the House of Representatives of the National Assembly of Belarus Vladimir Andreichenko at the Federal Council of Switzerland, BelTA learned from the Belarusian embassy in Switzerland.

During an official visit to Switzerland, Vladimir Andreichenko met with Federal Councilor, Head of the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs of Switzerland Ignazio Cassis. “Apart from different aspects of bilateral relations, the parties discussed matters related to regional security and also peacekeeping efforts of Belarus and Switzerland aimed at its improvement,” the embassy said.



The speaker held several more meetings in Bern. “During the talks with President of the National Council of Switzerland Dominique de Buman, the parties exchanged views on bilateral and multilateral cooperation. The intensification of trade and economic cooperation and deepening of loan and investment ties between Belarus and Switzerland were the main topics for discussion at a meeting of the chairman of the House of Representatives with State Secretary, Director of the Foreign Economic Affairs Directorate of Switzerland Marie-Gabrielle Ineichen-Fleisch,” the embassy said.



The official visit paid by the Belarusian delegation to Switzerland in late February-early March was the first official visit in the history of the Belarusian-Swiss inter-parliamentary relations.
